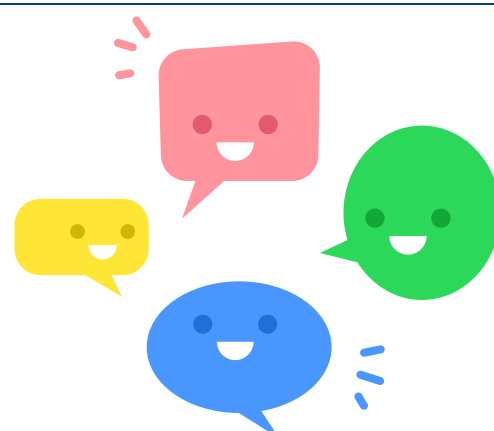
Disability Tax Credit Chat

Home Share

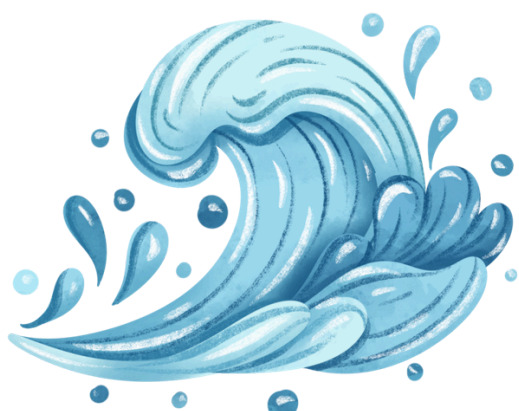
HomeShare is a new supportive living option in Nova Scotia that allows people with disabilities to live in a shared home with another Nova Scotian who provides support.
